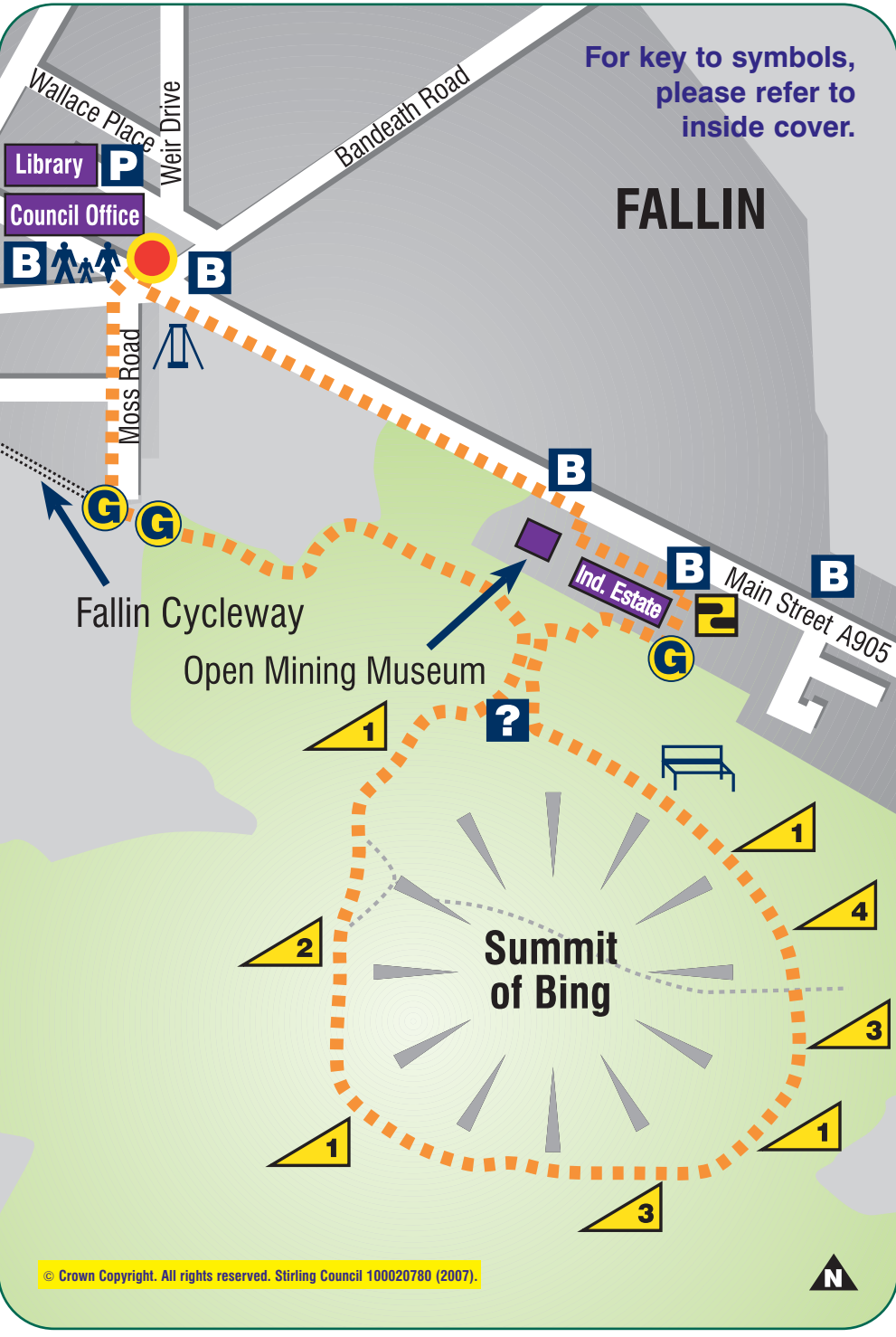

Fallin Bing is a countryside haven on a post-industrial site. Today you can find woodland and grassland where many important and diverse species live. See if you can spot a Common Blue butterfly or a 6 Spot Burnet moth. On a clear day you can enjoy views over to the Ochils.
