

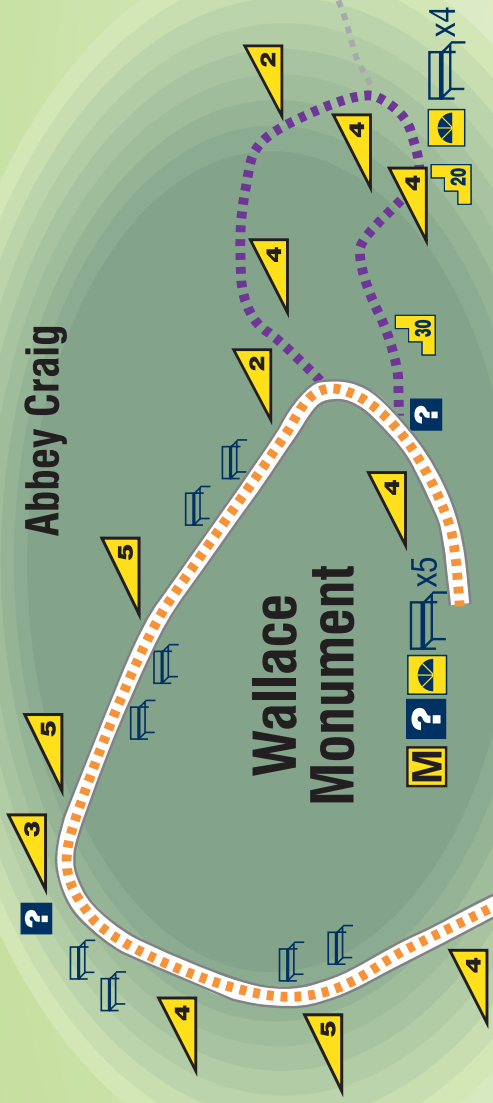

8. The Abbey Craig and Wallace Monument

Path grading: **A5** (extension D4)

Distance: 500 m from visitor centre to monument.
260 m extension

Brief Description

This walk gives you the opportunity to get up close to the famous Wallace Monument and enjoy stunning views up to the Trossachs and down the Forth Valley. Look out for woodland flora and fauna. If you are quiet you may spot a Roe deer.

Path Surfaces and Gradients

Path surfaces – Tarmac from the visitor centre to the monument. The circular route is half rough and half surfaced.

Gradient – Very steep gradient from the visitor centre to the monument. The circular route has short steep sections and steps on the rough section but is quite gentle on the surfaced section.
