


NEW - Carron Valley Area from 30 July 2018



Journeys may be made between any two points on the following roads (shown above in bold):

- B818 between Craignannet and Carron Bridge Hotel
- Unclassified road between Carron Bridge Hotel and Stirling via Loch Coulter and Howietoun Fishery
- Unclassified road between Loch Coulter Burn and Stirling via North Third Reservoir and Chartershall
- Unclassified road between Howlands and Foot o' Green
- Unclassified road via Cauldbarns and Craigend
- Unclassified road between Cauldbarns/Craigend and Auchebowie West
- Unclassified road between Craigend and Cangloar/Myres

Journeys may also be made between any point on the roads listed above and:

- St Ninians Health Centre
- Stirling Community Hospital
- Stirling City Centre
- Springkerse Retail Park

'Stirling City Centre' is defined as any publically-maintained road shown on the map below:

Bookings can be submitted online at any time, although requests submitted on a Saturday or Sunday or after 15:00 on a working day will be treated as having been received on the next working day. 'Working day' means any Monday to Friday other than 25-26 December and 01-02 January in any year.

Cancellations

If you require to cancel your DRT booking or make alternative arrangements phone 01786 404040 between 09:00 and 15:00 (Monday to Friday) or contact the operator directly out with these hours. Repeated cancellations without contacting the Council or operator will result in suspension of DRT services for the passenger. See operator details below:

Service Availability

The travel demands of prospective passengers will be met up to the level of driver and vehicle availability at the time requested. In the event that a prospective passenger's demand cannot be met at the time requested, the passenger will be offered the nearest available journey time. Your journey may be shared with other passengers.

Pick up and set-down points

Any location where it is safe to stop on adopted publicly-maintained roads wholly within the areas. A pickup point and time will be agreed when you pre-book.

Fares

Passengers pay the cost of a bus fare and Scottish National Entitlement Cards are accepted, as on bus services.
