

Arnprior is a small village with a population of approximately 80 and is located 14 miles west of Stirling on the A811 road. It originally grew as a service point for the agricultural community and today is a mixture of private and local authority housing. There is one shop and a petrol filling station.

Housing

Arnprior is a small linear village with no mains drainage and any new housing developed would require to be served by septic tanks or private treatment facilities. In addition the local primary school has recently closed. Given the current servicing constraints and the landscape setting of the village, it is not considered appropriate to allocate a specific site to accommodate local needs housing within the village, but the Council will give sympathetic consideration to small scale integrated proposals including provision of drainage infrastructure.

Environment

A Countryside Policy Boundary is identified to differentiate between village and countryside and to clarify where the Council's countryside protection planning policies apply. (See ENVIRONMENT chapter Para 2.22 and Policy E7).
