Meeting of Bannockburn Community Council , January 11th 2007

- Members Present : T Barlow , K McInnes , L Masterson , I Dawson , S Traynor

- Apologies : Police representative , Cllr T Coll , A MacPherson , J Grant.
- Opening Remarks : Before the meeting began a minutes silence was held in tribute to the late James Sharp.
A short discussion took place highlighting all that Jimmy had contributed to our community.
S.Traynor moved ;T Barlow seconded a motion that the Community Council should purchase a park bench in memory of Jimmy and should be sited in the environs of the Cenotaph.

- Matters Arising: 1/ T Barlow announced that the planning application for the Broomridge autopoint had been withdrawn.
2/ Further to recent report in the Stirling Observer, it was agreed to contact Stirling Council for an explanation as to why Amey were asking for the road at Chartershall to remain closed for up to 18 months

- Councillor Report: Full report posted on website. On the question of retention of CouncilHousing Stock- S Traynor asked why there was still a problem housing people when there were so many vacant properties available.
Councillor replied that it was more a question suitable accommodation rather than any accomodation

With that in mind , Kirk requested that flowers should be sent to Mrs J Sharp.

- 2/** T Barlow stated that a decision had to be made regarding the lockup in West Murrayfield ,following request from the Council seeking rental fees It was agreed that T Barlow was to search the office for a letter stating that the Community Council had been granted the lockup free gratis.
- 3/** J Dreczkowski raised the Health & Safety aspect of the equipment and it's usage .T Barlow to contact Countryside Rangers for assistance therefore in any future ventures.
- 4/**T Barlow requested that any items for The Bannockburn News using his name should only be those which have already been ratified by the Community Council.
- 5/** The Chair stated that he was reminding all community councillors when they were contacting any outside agency that unless they were operating with the full backing and understanding of the Community Council ,they were doing so as a private individual.
