W.McCulloch attended on behalf of Milton Amateurs to ask why Bannockburn Community Council had objected to Milton Amateurs Application for the lease of the Pavillion adjacent to the new Hillpark Community Centre .Terry explained that a letter had been received by Kirk as Chair of Bannockburn Community Council asking for any comments . Since the Pavillion was no longer in our jurisdiction ,Terry arranged a meeting with two members of Hillpark/Milton Community Council along with himself and Iain Dawson (Bannockburn Community Trust), this meeting was attended by Ben O'Connell of Active Stirling. It was explained to Mr O'Connell by the Community Councillors that they were unhappy that since the changing Pavillion had been refurbished with monies originally allocated for the new Community Centre they felt that they should have a role in who could use the facilities if Milton were not doing so - it was agreed that this matter is between Hillpark/Milton Community Council and Active Stirling.

The chair thanked those present for attending , closed the meeting and reminded them all of the next gathering on 1st November 2007.
