TREASURER'S REPORT

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the Treasurer, John Gil, has had to stand down as Office Bearer at short notice. Keith Ironside was proposed by Les Ferguson as new Treasurer, seconded by Alison Logie. Keith agreed to over responsibilities as Treasurer. As a result of recent changes, Keith advised that the Annual Accounts would be prepared and audited for a future meeting. However it was noted that the balance of account currently stood at £590.65 and the War Memorial account totalled £10,400.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Chair gave an account of what the Community Council had achieved since it reconvened in February.

In four months, members had attended meetings with various officers of Stirling and achieved the following -

- successfully facilitated a hustings for local government election candidates
- provided organised opposition to the TACTRAN proposals for a road from Kildean to the University
- proposed street name "Chalmers Court"
- formed a sub-committee to carry out an audit of recreational facilities
- succeeded in having bus stop in Fountain Road repositioned
- succeeded in having lights in health centre car park replaced
- got agreement from Stirling Council for a disabled parking space on Henderson Street
- re-formed links with the Merchants Association
- supported Stirling Before Pylons
- carried out replanting at Blairforkie Drive
