

The Council-supported network is:

- supplementary journeys operating as extensions to commercial services, mainly in early mornings, evenings and on Sundays;
- EasyBoarder wheelchair-accessible services offering greater accessibility to everyone, including people who cannot easily use conventional buses.
Easyboarder Services are as follows:
 - Service C34 operated by Harlequin Coaches Ltd. runs from Plean, Cowie, Throsk, Fallin, Springkerse, Stirling City Centre and Stirling Royal Infirmary.
 - Service C31 operated by Harlequin Coaches Ltd. runs between Causewayhead and Stirling City Centre.
 - Service C30 operated by Harlequin Coaches Ltd. runs between Riverside, Stirling City Centre.
- services in rural areas that are not commercial, such as Strathfillan, Killin, the Trossachs and Strathard;
- cross-border links provided in partnership with other authorities, such as Balfron - Balloch, Stirling - Crieff and Alexandria - Balmaha;
- services funded through the Scottish Executive Rural Transport Fund. Rural Rider is a local bus service designed to meet the needs of those living in the rural and more remote areas:
 - Service R7 operated by Harlequin Coaches Ltd. runs from Stirling, Gargunnoch, Kippen, Fintry and Balfron on Monday, Wednesday and Friday only;
 - Wee County Boarder Service 69 operated by 'First' runs from Stirling, Tillicoultry and Kinross on Sunday only;
 - Service C17 operated by Addison of Callander runs from Gartmore, Aberfoyle, Callander and McLaren Leisure Centre (operates Brig o'Turk and Kilmahog on demand) on Monday, Wednesday and Friday only.
 - Service C18 operated by Addison of Callander runs from Inversnaid, Aberfoyle, Callander and McLaren Leisure Centre (operates Inversnaid and Kinlochard on demand) on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday only;
 - Service C60 operated by Kingshouse Travel Ltd. runs from Tyndrum to McLaren Leisure Centre (operates Balquhidder on demand) on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday evenings.
