Council Tax Discount : Claim Form Student Nurse

Background

A full council tax bill assumes that there are two adults (aged 18 or over) living in a household. If there are less than two adults resident there, 25% or 50% discount may be due. Certain Student Nurses are not counted (with adults) when working out a discount.

A student nurse is a person who:

- is attending a course at a college of Nursing or Midwifery, or a College of Health established by a Health Board or by a Regional or District Health Authority.
- and**
- is attending a course which, if successfully completed, leads to their registration on any of Parts 1 to 8 of the register maintained under Section 10 of the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 **for the first time.**

Description of a Student Nurse for Council Tax purposes

A student nurse is a person who

- is attending a course at a college of Nursing or Midwifery, or a College of Health established by a Health Board or by a Regional or District Health Authority

and

- is attending a course which, if successfully completed, leads to their registration on any of Parts 1 - 8 of the Register maintained under Section 10 of the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 **for the first time.**

- Part 1 First level nurses trained in general nursing.
- Part 2 Second level nurses trained in general nursing (England and Wales)
- Part 3 First level nurses trained in the nursing of persons suffering from mental illness
- Part 4 Second level nurses trained in the nursing of persons suffering from mental illness (England and Wales)
- Part 5 First level nurses training in the nursing of persons suffering from mental handicap
- Part 6 Second level nurses trained in the nursing of persons suffering from mental handicap (England and Wales)
- Part 7 Second level nurses (Scotland and Northern Ireland)
- Part 8 Nurses trained in the nursing of sick children

Please note a Nursing Diploma Student (formerly known as a Project 2000 Nurse) is counted as a student for discount purposes. A separate claim form is available.
