6. Planning:

Applications received;

- a) Aberfoyle Primary School, replacement of nursery building – Refused unanimously. Objections:**
Position of new building blocks access for school house giving potential problem for emergency services. Position of new build in front of listed building impinges on the character of the original. Position also does not maximise play area for children – space is already at a premium. General design of building not a problem, more the positioning of it.
- b) Inversnaid Bunkhouse; erection of new building, managers residence. Approve unanimously.**
Agrees with CC wish to encourage living and working within the community.
- c) Corrieichon- adjacent building –5 approve 1 against. Concern raised re nesting swifts at the property which are protected. (NB: post-meeting queried water supply, which is limited in this area.)**
- d) Relacement windows at 3 Craiguchty Terr.**
