### 3. Matters Arising

#### Flashing Road Sign

#### Speed Limit

The present change to the system (60 to 50mph at end of the village and 40mph sign being moved) will take 11 weeks. An update needed for the 30mph mandate, which was put in on May.

### Cycle Track

**Pedestrian/Cycle Link:** A fully paved pedestrian/cycle link shall be provided to access the site from the footway along A905 Kersie Road in the vicinity of Building 4 in order to provide direct access to the development for pedestrians and cyclists from the adjacent public road, prior to the occupation of any units on the site.

**Cycle Parking Provision:** Prior to the occupation of any units on the site, a covered secure cycle parking provision for 14 cycles shall be provided to serve the development. (This may be provided within a shared, centrally located shelter area, suitably located within the site). Details of the location and design of the covered cycle parking facility shall be submitted to the Planning Authority and approved in writing prior to work commencing on site

The pedestrian/cycle link will run from the industrial site out onto a footway to the east of the housing at Throsk. The anticipated route will be well set back from housing in the area.
