

## Minute of the meeting of Torbrex Community Council held in Stirling High School at 7.15pm on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2007.

- 2. Minute of the Previous Meeting:** The minute of the previous meeting of 26<sup>th</sup> September was accepted as an accurate record of the meeting.
- 3. Matters arising - Friends of Beechwood Park:** Murray confirmed that a meeting had been arranged at Stirling High School on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> November to discuss the standing of the Friends of Beechwood Park group and its relationship with Torbrex Community Council.
- 4. Orchard House Update:** Murray provided an update on the meeting held by Forth Valley Health Board at which Nicola Sturgeon, Minister for Health & Well Being had been present. He reported that there remained many issues to be resolved regarding the provision of community health care and it was agreed that Torbrex Community Council would write to Forth Valley Health Board seeking a key stage review, asking that information be shared with the community and opportunities for engagement put forward.
- 5. NHS Scotland – Better Health, Better Care:** Members were advised of an invitation received from NHS Scotland to attend a meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> November at 6pm in the Conference Centre at Stirling Royal Infirmary.
- 6. Community Council Vacancy – Elections 2008:** The secretary reported that Torbrex Community Council had received notification from Stirling Council that elections to fill vacancies that may exist in Community Councils may take place during January / February 2008. Murray advised that he would write to Helen Geddes at Stirling Council for guidance in amending our constitution in order to increase the number of councillors in view of planned future housing developments within Torbrex.
- 7. Waterwatch Scotland, South East Panel – Public Meeting:** Members were advised that Waterwatch Scotland are holding a public meeting on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> November in the Park Hotel, Falkirk at 6pm. After discussion we agreed upon the submission of questions regarding future plans related to water supply.
- 8. A.O.C.B. – Footpath:** It was agreed that we would try to find out who owned the footpath that runs behind Stirling Ice Rink through to the Scout Headquarters, the secretary would pursue this.
