## **NOTES FOR APPLICANTS**

1. Applications should be completed and returned together with the fee to Stirling Council, Network Management, Endrick House, Kerse Road, Stirling FK7 7SN. If you have any enquiries about any aspect of your application, please call Network Management on 01786 404040.
2. The £161.00 / £81.00 fee will be charged for each application to cover the cost of site inspection, processing of applications, preparing plan, site marking and administration.
3. Applicants will be notified within four weeks of the date of receipt of the application. The fee will only be charged for successful applications.

## **General Comments**

If you access your driveway by a dropped kerb and regularly have problems with vehicles blocking your access, you can apply for an access protection marking.

An access protection marking is an advisory marking which is used to highlight a dropped kerb to motorists.

Access protection markings cannot be enforced by Police Scotland. Police Scotland can, however, take action against vehicles obstructing your access without the need for the marking.
