

Tablet Lending – Conditions of Use

Stirling Council Libraries offers the opportunity to borrow tablets within the confines of its Terms of Use policy. These terms are summarized here –

To borrow a tablet you must:

- Be 16 years old or over

Conditions of tablet loan:

- Only one tablet can be borrowed per person
- Tablets can be borrowed for 3 weeks and will be auto-renewed for up to 12 weeks if there are no reservations
- Borrowers may be charged if the device is lost or damaged beyond use. The following charges could be applied:
Tablet = £182
Charger = £12
Cover = £12

Return of tablet

- Tablets should be returned promptly at the end of the loan period or when asked to by staff.
- Tablets should be returned in the same condition as when issued and any damage or problems should be highlighted to staff
- Tablets should be wiped of all personal data following instructions given

MiFis are supplied by Connecting Scotland and unlimited data is provided however, this is subject to fair usage.

The Library Service is not responsible for the accuracy of material viewed on the Internet, nor for others who may access the device when it is on loan. Stirling Council accepts no responsibility for materials accessed by persons under 16 which may be considered unsuitable by parent or guardian.

Users who access URLs that provide streaming media from the BBC should reside at an address that has a registered TV licence.

On-line financial transactions are undertaken and personal/private details are broadcast at the user's own risk.

Stirling Council is not responsible for the contraction of any computer viruses during use of its equipment.

Users should be aware that Copyright Law may apply to some materials and that compliance with the law is the responsibility of the user.

The following actions will not be acceptable to Stirling Council Libraries and will result in the individual's access to the tablet lending scheme being withdrawn. This includes but is

not limited to the following activities:

- The transmission of SPAM, viruses or any other type of malware
- Hacking and unauthorised access to other devices and networks or scanning of ports
- Attacks on networks or devices connected to a network.
- Fraud, forgery or theft
- Transmission of any material which is threatening in nature, including activity deemed to be libel, harassment and defamation
- Transmission or storage of material of an offensive nature including pornographic, obscene, indecent, abusive or harmful and material offensive to children
- Acts of terrorism
- Wilful damage to the tablet
