Gender-Based Violence Partnership	Improving Outcomes for Children in Need of Protection Improving Outcomes for Children and Young People with Care Experience	Delivers on "Equally Safe" Includes action to implement Safe and Together practice model in domestic abuse situations.

Community Learning & Development Plan	Improving Outcomes for Children and Young People with Care Experience Tackling Child Poverty	Includes youth work provision, family learning, and employability.

Early Learning and Childcare Plan	All 5 improvement areas	Sets out plans for delivery of the 1140 hours of early learning and childcare to all 3 and 4 year olds and eligible 2 year olds.

Excellence and Equity Strategy	Tackling Child Poverty Improving Outcomes for Children and Young People with Care Experience	Focuses on raising the attainment of children and young people affected by socio-economic disadvantage. Sets the expectation that all educational establishments in Stirling will “ensure learning experiences are... accessible to all; regularly track and monitor progress and impact.”
Local Policing Plan	Improving Outcomes for Children in Need of Protection Improving Outcomes for Children and Young People with Care Experience	Actions include: holding Inter-Agency Referral Discussions to consider child protection concerns, identify the risk factors and associated protective measures needed; using early and effective intervention as an opportunity to promote the development of children and young people involved in low level offending behaviour; raising awareness of the threats posed from online grooming and the sharing of self-generated indecent images; and ensuring the preventative advice police give to children and young people is tailored to their age and level of understanding.
NHS Forth Valley Healthcare Strategy	All 5 improvement areas	Recognises that integrated and co-ordinated services are required at the point of transition to adult services. Aims to ensure that children and young people achieve the best possible outcomes by having equitable access to safe, effective and child centred health services.
Physical Activity, Sport and Healthy Living Strategy	All 5 improvement areas	An aspirational, 10-year framework for all people, across all communities in Stirling, to ensure a better understanding of the benefits of being active, staying active, and eating a balanced diet.
Better Hearings Programme of Improvement	Improving Outcomes for Children in Need of Protection Improving Outcomes for Children and Young People with Care Experience	Sets out a range of planned child-centred actions to improve children and young people’s experiences of Children’s Hearings.
Locality Action Plans (x8)	Tackling child poverty	Set out what partners are going to do to make a difference in communities where people experience significantly poorer outcomes which result from socio-economic disadvantage. Child poverty is an identified priority in all 8 localities.

Effective and supportive adult health and social care services will improve life for the families of service users, including their children. Seamless transitions into adult services, where required, will improve outcomes for the young people concerned.

Local Housing Strategy	Tackling Child Poverty Improving Outcomes for Children and Young People with Care Experience	Sets out the local direction for housing need and demand. It also informs future investment in housing and related services.
NHSFV Health Improvement Strategy 17 – 21	All 5 Improvement areas	Sets out the vision for the provision of healthcare in Forth Valley, focused on tackling preventable illness, reducing the inequality gap and promoting physical and mental wellbeing.
